



Instructions

1. Print this page at full scale.
2. Use a pencil (if transferring onto rubberish material) or charcoal (if transferring onto lino) to fully shade in the letters, flora and borders. Press hard. Cover all the black areas (except for any you don't want on your block or stamp).
3. Cut out the full 4x6" image.
4. Flip it over so the design is facing down, and hold the paper centred on the carving surface of your lino or rubber block. With your other hand, use a bone folder or the flat edge of your pencil to rub the full image firmly. The marks will be transferred onto the block.
5. Use a ballpoint pen or permanent marker to fill in the transferred design so you can clearly see it.
6. Carve the negative space, leaving the markings untouched.
